

Congress passed the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations

Washington, DC (May 30th) - On Thursday, May 24th, Congress passed the Emergency Supplemental Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2007, to fund vital government programs. Included in the supplemental is \$6.3 billion for Hurricane relief assistance in areas affected by 2005 hurricanes. Funding includes the appropriation of \$4.1 billion for FEMA and \$1.4 billion for the Army Corps of Engineers. It also provides \$175 million for projects by the Corps relating to natural disasters.
